
The assembled product is shown in the right figure. A pull rod can be seen below the right side of the seat plate. When the pull rod is pulled, the direction of the seat plate can be rotated and adjusted.



WARNING:




1. Insert the 4 chair legs (2) into each of the tubes located on the underside of the seat frame (1). Ensure that the push button on each chair leg clicks out fully and the legs are secure.

2. Set the chair to an appropriate seat height. The legs are adjustable to four levels. Ensure that the push button on each chair leg clicks out fully and the legs are secure.



3. Attach the two armrests (7) to each side of the seat frame. Ensure that the push button on each clicks out fully. Lock the front section into the seat guide.

Note: To raise the armrest, pull it up to release the arm from its guide and rotate it back out of the way (it may require a little force to clear the support guide (A)).



4. Insert the assembled backrest **(B)** into the corresponding pipe opening of the main frame in the direction shown in the diagram (ensure that the marble of each backrest pipe pops out fully).

The position of the shower head buckle (8) can be adjusted for better convenience.
